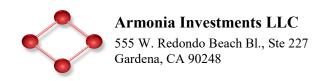

The objective is that every student at 118th Street Elementary School will have school supplies needed for distance learning and to participate in the science fair. Funding in the amount of \$2, 168.86 is requested for school supplies and science fair presentation tri-folds.

Statement of Need
