

Harbor Gateway North Neighborhood Special Board Meeting

Thursday, April 14, 2022

Held via Zoom webinar

1) Call to order and roll call of Board members: Chair Miguel Vazquez called the Board meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. Roll call determined that a quorum of Board members was present.

2) General public comment on non-agenda items that are within the Board's jurisdiction: There was no public comment.

3) Approval of up to \$2,300 for printing of flyers by Minuteman Press and delivery by Walking Man to 10,000 HGNNC households to advertise the Sat. May 7 at 2 p.m. Council District 15 Candidate Forum to be held via Zoom: It was moved by Richard Lee, seconded by Rosalie Preston, and passed 9-0-0 to approve this expenditure to better publicize the CD 15 Candidate Forum to HGNNC stakeholders.

4) Approval of up to \$2,500 in matching funds for a KLAB Community Beautification Grant (Beautify LA Grant) for an HGNNC supported beautification project – May 4 deadline, with the possibility of using the HGNNC Clean Streets LA funds: Chair Miguel Vazquez said that he would like to propose that the HGNNC apply for a Beautify LA Grant to plant native or other drought-tolerant plants in the Stanford Avenue parkways north of the 105 freeway and to possibly use funds from the Clean Streets LA funds. He will serve as the project manager and submit the paperwork by the May 4 deadline. It was moved by Richard Lee, seconded by Rosalie Preston, and passed to approve support for the Beautify LA Grant.
