**Miguel Vasquez:** <u>Nunc Pro Tunc (then for now) Addendum to Report (4)[e]</u> <u>of April 21, 2023, Minutes</u>: A social cost of carbon is the cost of the damage created by one extra ton of carbon dioxide emissions.

When calculating the social cost of carbon, the main components are what happens to the climate and how these changes affect economic outcomes, including changes in agricultural productivity, damages caused by sea level rise, and decline in human health and labor productivity.

Policymakers use the social cost of carbon to quantify the extra costs associated with carbon emissions that are not automatically reflected in market prices. This helps them better compare the costs and benefits of specific environmental policies

policies.
